- ◆ **Non-refundable jurying fee: \$10**
- ◆ Booth fee for the one-day Fair (includes complimentary coffee and breakfast item):
  - Aisle Space: \$ 75**
  - Corner Space: \$ 80**
  - Double Space: \$ 130**
- ◆ No commission will be charged.
- ◆ Spaces are 8'x 10' in both the gym and cafeteria. The hall spaces are 6' x 12'.
- ◆ To ensure consideration in the first jury session, applications must be received by April 16<sup>th</sup>. Thereafter, applications will be reviewed on a space- available basis.

## Additional information about the NJWC Annual Harvest Craft Fair

- Crafters will be responsible for their own display. Tables are not provided. However, one chair per booth space will be available.
- There is **NO SMOKING** allowed, inside or outside the building due to State law.
- We invite you to donate one craft item representative of your professional craft to our Crafters' Raffle. This is a voluntary donation; however, it gives your craft additional exposure and it is appreciated!
- Hospitality people will be available to provide directions and information. However, you will need to make your own provisions for your personal needs such as lunchtime.
- A complimentary coffee and breakfast item will be available.
- A map to the Robert E. Melican Middle School along with your booth number will be mailed to you prior to the Fair.
- Accepted crafters' photos will be returned the day of the Fair. If you are not accepted, your booth fee check and photos will be returned by mail if you have provided a self-addressed envelope with adequate postage.
- **SPECIAL BONUS:** Two complimentary admission tickets will be mailed to all accepted crafters whose applications are received by the April 16<sup>th</sup> deadline.

### ***Exhibiting crafters must agree to the following:***

- All crafts must be the original creation of the entrant.
- All work must be personally handcrafted, no imports allowed.
- No kits or catalog items will be accepted.
- Crafters must bring only the craft(s) stated.
- Crafters must bring their own table(s).
- Crafters using electricity must bring their own extension cords.
- The use of spray sealants in the building is not allowed.
- All tables must be covered to the floor.
- A refund will only be allowed prior to August 1, 2017 after which time no refund will be given.

### **To be considered for this well-respected, professional craft fair, please submit:**

- Completed application form
- Payment in full at time of application - 2 separate checks (or money orders)
- Four clear, color photos of your craft **including booth set-up**
- Self-addressed envelope with adequate postage for photo return
- **Apply before April 16th to ensure your application is reviewed in our first jury session.**
